2022 AGM

Due to the continuing uncertainties with COVID and the success of the 2021 AGM by Zoom the League Executive Committee have decided that the 2022 AGM will again be held via Zoom. As before, due to the practicality of doing this with the numbers involved one nominated member from each club will be invited to the meeting on their club's behalf, and they will hold all their club's votes. The number of votes will be set according to the number of teams that club had in the league during the 2021 season. The nominated person will be extra to any League Executive Committee members attending who will not get a vote unless they are also their club's nominated representative. A Zoom link will be sent to each Club Match Secretary a week before the AGM which is on Thursday 24th February at 7.30pm.
