

Southport and District Junior Tennis League Report 2021

Although the Junior Reps were keen to provide competitive tennis this season, we discussed the practicalities of running the league under Covid-19 restrictions and it was thought that there were still too many uncertainties and challenges to organise a junior league for a May start.

We took into account:

The lack of tennis played by juniors (due to restrictions) and hence difficulty in selecting teams

Travel and movement between different Counties

Toilets and facilities re-opening

Transport of players in individual cars without car sharing

Postponement of matches due to Covid-19 cases within teams and clubs

Risk assessments, event delivery plans and social distancing

A later start to competitive play was preferable and we considered more suitable formats of match play for the season.

Alternatives proposed were a weekend of Team Tennis in late June or early July and/or a singles tournament to run over several weeks.

Unfortunately only one club was able to offer a venue for the Team Tournaments and so we were unable to go ahead this year. Feedback from other clubs was understandably that the club diary was booked up with internal competitions and events this season as members returned to playing tennis.

Sadly the continued restrictions prevented us from organising competitive play this season for the Junior League.

We hope that everyone stays safe and we very much look forward to a return to the League next season.
